
Changes to BGC Board Membership in 2023

New BGC Chairs



Subena Colligan, M.S., CIH, CSP, is the Principal Coach and Consultant at S. Colligan Coaching. She is an Air Force Veteran and Chair-Elect Director of the Board for Global EHS Credentialing. Subena is a member of the AIHA minority special interest group, Women in IH, and the Total Worker Health Advisory Group. She has dedicated her efforts to the belief that Occupational Environmental Health and Safety professionals impact the world by providing safe and healthy environments for people to innovate and thrive in. She becomes BGC Chair on January 1, 2023, succeeding Thomas (Tom) Grumbles, CIH, FAIHA, CPPS, who becomes BGC Past Chair.



Thomas (Tom) Grumbles, CIH, FAIHA, CPPS, has over 40 years of experience in industrial hygiene and product safety compliance in the chemical industry. He has led the implementation of global product stewardship programs and REACH compliance efforts for the Global Chemicals business of Sasol. He also led compliance efforts with chemical regulations in North America under the US Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), state regulations such as California Proposition 65, and multiple Global Chemical regulatory schemes. He has served as the Company Chair of the Health, Products, and Science Policy Committee at the American Chemistry Council, President of the American Industrial Hygiene Association, and the International Occupational Hygiene Association. He is a 2015 winner of the AIHA Distinguished Service Award and is currently the Past President of the Product Stewardship Society. He becomes BGC Past Chair on January 1, 2023, succeeding Alan Leibowitz, who is rotating off the board's Past Chair role.

New Electronic Certificates!

BGC is excited to announce our new electronic certificates! Now our Diplomates can print their certificates anytime, anywhere.

A useful feature on the certificates is a scan QR code that will take you directly to Credly where you, a colleague, or a client can verify your badge.

We have issued digital badges to everyone. To have access to your certificate, you must have accepted the badge from the email we sent. You share the badge and download the certificate in the same area at Credly.com.

To print your electronic certificate, do the following:

- Access your Credly account
- Go to your Dashboard
- Click Share
- Under Publish, click Download Certificate
- On the **Print** screen, click **Download PDF**

Reminder: after January 1st, 2023, BGC will no longer be automatically sending printed certificates for new, recertified, or reinstated Diplomates.

CM Tips: How to Calculate Hours from CEUs for a Course

Some course providers use CEUs to determine the time for an event. Please use this simple formula to determine how many hours can be claimed for an event that uses CEUs:

1 CEU equals 10 technical contact hours or 1.6 CEUs equals 16 technical contact hours.

Please keep a record for the courses you attend that includes the following information in case of an audit:

- Diplomate's Name
- Event Title
- Date of Completion
- Event Sponsor/Provider
- Duration (e.g., hours or CEUs)

If any of this information is missing or if the subject matter is not clear from the title, then additional records will be needed (e.g., event description, agenda, or schedule).

Upcoming Certification Deadlines

Please note the following deadlines for BGC credentialing programs. Be sure to pay all fees and submit all application or recertification materials before the deadline to avoid late charges.

Certified Industrial Hygienist (CIH)

CIH examinations are offered in the spring and fall of each year. All application documents from all sources must be submitted, all materials uploaded, and fees paid by the deadline. All submitted materials must be approved by BGC in order to sit for the exam.

- Application/reapplication deadline for Spring 2023 is February 1, 2023
- Application/reapplication deadline for Fall 2023 is August 1, 2023

CIH recertification/certification-maintenance (CM) deadlines are based on the end date of your recertification cycle. Please refer to your certificate or log in to your CAPS profile to determine your deadline.

- CM deadline for the cycle ending December 31, 2022 is **February 1, 2023**
- CM deadline for the cycle ending June 30, 2023 is **August 1, 2023**

Certified Professional Environmental Auditor (CPEA)

CPEAs are being transitioned to 5-year recertification (CM/CPD) cycles. Your deadline for submitting your Attestation of Recertification Activities form can be found through the online CPEA CM Handbook - Documents and Forms page.

• CM deadline for the cycle ending December 31, 2022, is **February 1, 2023**

Certified Professional Process Safety Auditor (CPSA)

CPSAs are being transitioned to 5-year recertification (CM/CPD) cycles. Your deadline for submitting your Attestation of Recertification Activities form can be found through the online CPSA CM Handbook - Documents and Forms page.

• CM deadline for the cycle ending December 31, 2022, is **February 1, 2023**

Certified Professional Product Steward (CPPS)

All application documents from all sources must be submitted, all materials uploaded, and fees paid by the deadline. All submitted materials must be approved by BGC in order to sit for the exam.

- CPPS application deadline for Fall 2023 is **June 1, 2023**
- CPPS application deadline for Spring 2024 is **December 1, 2023**

CPPS recertification deadlines are based on the end date of your recertification cycle. Please refer to your BGC certificate to confirm your deadline.

- Recertification deadline for cycle ending June 30, 2025 is August 1, 2025
- Recertification deadline for cycle ending December 31, 2025 is February 1, 2026

Environmental Professional In-Training (EPI)

The EPI designation has no reporting requirement for recertification other than annual dues payment as you gain experience in preparation for the QEP credential. You may only hold the designation for seven years without sitting for the QEP exam.

Qualified Environmental Professional (QEP)

QEP recertification deadlines are on a five-year cycle, on the last day of the month in which you originally passed your QEP exam.

• Please log in to your QEP profile to confirm your deadline date.

Certified Associate Industrial Hygienist (CAIH)

CAIH recertification/certification-maintenance (CM) deadlines are based on the end date of your recertification cycle.

- CM deadline for the cycle ending December 31, 2022, is **February 1, 2023**
- CM deadline for the cycle ending June 30, 2023, is **August 1, 2023**
